

PHOTOGRAPHIC SAFARI TOURS

PHOTOGRAPHIC SAFARIS

You will be met at the Cape Town International Airport by your SATour accredited guide and transferred to your HOTEL after which you will be taken on an orientation tour of Cape Town.

PENINSULA TOUR.

A scenic drive along the Atlantic Coast taking in *Sea Point, Clifton, Camps Bay, Llandudno and Hout Bay*. Through the *Constantia Valley* to *Muizenberg* and along *Boyces Drive*, through the coastal towns of *St. James Kalk Bay, Fish Hoek and Simonstown*. Visit the unique colony of *Jackass Penguins* at the *Boulders* before entering the floral reserve of the *Cape Point Nature Reserve*, home to many species of fynbos, reptiles, birds and antelope. A funicular ride to the light house at the tip of the Peninsula at *Cape Point* where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet and a 10 minute return walk, followed by a stop at the *Cape of Good Hope*. Lunch at a seafood restaurant in the picturesque historic town of *Simonstown*. An optional visit to *Topstones* the world's largest gem tumbling plant. This is followed by a half hour walk through *Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens* – the premier botanical garden in the world.

WINELANDS TOUR.

A trip out to *Stellenbosch and Franschoek*. This tour can be a wine tasting tour, stopping off at about five different *Wine Estates* and a brief tour through the *City of the Oaks – Stellenbosch* steeped in history and old *Cape Dutch Architecture*. Lunch at the top of *Helshoogte Pass* with a magnificent view overlooking the *Franschoek Valley*.

Either continue into the town of *Franschoek* to see the *Huguenot Monument* or take in more wine farms. For those not wanting to do tasting, a visit to the *Village Museum* and tour of *Stellenbosch University* campus and other places of interest.

SWARTLAND TOUR.

This includes visiting *Malmesbury* with tea at a farmhouse on the *Kasteelberg*. *Riebeeck Kasteel and Riebeeck West* are small villages we visit which can include wine tasting. A traditional Cape lunch in historic *Tulbagh* with a stroll down *Church Street*. Return to Cape Town via beautiful *Paarl*.

CITY TOUR.

Visiting places of interest in the city centre, a walk through the *Company Gardens, Green Market Square, The Malay Quarter, District Six Museum and Table Mountain*. Great shopping

SOUTH COAST TOUR.

We visit the wine estate *Vergelegen in Somerset West*, before taking the coastal road to *Betty's Bay and Hermanus* where we watch the *whales in Walker Bay*. Return to Cape Town via *Sir Lowry's Pass*.

SHARK ENCOUNTER

Weather permitting you will be picked up and driven to *Gansbaai* where you embark for your dive 12km offshore near *Dyer Island*. Use is made of specially designed, secure, two man cage which floats on the surface with our divers no more than 1m below the surface. Only

experienced divers are permitted in the cage and our non divers will have a great opportunity to watch the great white sharks feeding from the safety of the top deck of the boat. Sharks are most active in the winter months between *May and September*. The 26ft boat is licenced to carry 8 guests and has a spacious cabin, toilet and flying bridge. Price of this tour is not included in daily rate. *\$240 per person*.

LEAVE CAPE TOWN FOR THE GARDEN ROUTE WHERE YOU WILL OVERNIGHT IN MOSSEL BAY

OUDTSHOORN

Visit a *Wildlife Ranch* where *cheetah, leopard and crocodiles* can be seen. Ride an *ostrich* and visit the enormous and beautiful *Cango Caves*. Shopping for ostrich purses, belts etc. is recommended in the town and then to

KNYSNA.

We visit the beaches and enjoy the wonderful scenery in this pretty coastal town where many artists live Overnight here.

PLETTENBERG BAY AND MONKEYLAND

Another beautiful coastal village with outstanding views and then to Monkeyland – to see the monkeys. Then to *Port Elizabeth* – overnight here. Then to

ADDO ELEPHANT PARK

This park has the densest population of elephant in South Africa – voted the best spot in Africa to view elephants. Overnight near park.

SHAMWARI GAME RESERVE

Enjoy tribal singing, dancing and village life, visit the Born Free Foundation then have lunch after which enjoy a game drive where you will have the opportunity of seeing *Lion, elephant, rhino, buffalo, giraffe, hippo* and various species of antelope. The cost of this tour is not included in the daily rate \$240 per person. overnight at Bowker Safaris in the Thorn kloof Reserve.

DOUBLE DRIFT GAME RESERVE

On the Fish River where *elephant, rhino, buffalo, giraffe* and antelope can be seen. overnight at *Bowker Safaris at Thornkloof* again

GRAHAMSTOWN AND PORT ALFRED.

Visit Grahamstown a frontier town with wonderfully preserved buildings and then travel to Port Alfred on the Indian Ocean where we visit a carpet factory where carpets are handmade and designed. Lunch overlooking the Indian Ocean. Overnight *Port Alfred*.

Back to PORT ELIZABETH FOR FLIGHT TO USA.
